The Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) is hosting a Live Virtual Public Information Meeting on **Wednesday, February 8, 2023** to provide an overview of the Route 20 Reconstruction Project in Charlton & Oxford. The meeting will begin with a presentation by the project team including a project timeline and design and construction information. Attendees can view project plans and ask questions.

### How will this affect you?

MassDOT is redesigning and reconstructing Route 20 in Charlton and Oxford to improve safety and traffic operations. Proposed work includes widening the roadway, replacing bridges over the Little River and the French River, adding sidewalks and shared use paths, installing a median barrier, improving safety and traffic operations at various intersections, and enhancing stormwater treatment.
