What is happening?

An in-person Public Information Meeting will be held for the Route 3A reconstruction project from Richardson Road extending southerly onto Route 4 to the intersection with Technology Drive. A traffic signal is proposed to be installed at the Route 3A (Princeton Street)/Richardson Road intersection.

How will this affect you?

- The Route 3A (Princeton Street)/Richardson Road intersection will have improved safety with the new traffic signal.
- Access management will be consolidated at driveways.
- Pedestrian and bicycle facilities will be constructed.
