What is happening? The purpose of this meeting is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed bridge reconstruction project, Western Avenue (US Route 127) over Blynman Canal in Gloucester. All views and comments submitted in response to the meeting will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

How will this affect you? The proposed project includes the reconstruction of the Western Avenue (US Route 127) over Blynman Canal moveable span bridge. A full roadway closure and detour at the moveable span will be necessary during portions of the project. Navigation Channel closures will be required during portions of the project and coordinated with the United States Coast Guard.
