What is happening?

A live virtual public information meeting will be hosted on the MassDOT website below to present the design for the Northern Strand Extension project in the municipalities of Lynn and Nahant.

How will this affect you?

This project extends from the Northern Strand terminus at Western Ave, along Market Square, S Common Street, Market Street, the Lynnway (Carroll Parkway), and Nahant Road – approximately 1.9 miles. The purpose of this Project is to provide safer and improved transportation access for bicycle users and pedestrians. This project seeks to accomplish this through the construction of a two-way separated bike lane and shared-use trail facility for bicycle and pedestrian users.
