

Marion-Wareham Bridge Replacement Virtual Public Information Meeting

What is happening?

The Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) is hosting a Live Virtual Public Information Meeting on **Thursday, August 21 at 6:00PM**. At this meeting, the project team will provide an overview of the project and upcoming construction activities and impacts for the Marion-Wareham Bridge Replacement project. The meeting will begin with a presentation by the project team, followed by time for attendees to ask questions.

How will this affect you?

MassDOT is replacing two bridges on Route 6 northbound and southbound over the Weweantic River in the towns of Marion and Wareham to improve bridge and roadway conditions and safety. Proposed work includes removal of existing bridge structures, roadway reconstruction, environmental protections and improvements to pedestrian access and safety including the installation of a shared use path.
