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


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Public Meeting Notes and Procedures


Why was this project initiated?

Location Map

The project location is on Jefferson Ave., between Cleveland St. and Adams St., South of the MBTA RR Tracks.



Bridge Location





Existing Conditions

- Latest inspection report (7/28/2022) shows extensive deterioration to bridge structure
- Vertical clearance under the bridge is too short for delivery and refuse vehicles
- Horizontal clearance under the bridge allows for only one direction of traffic at a time
- The existing bridge structure creates blind spots for vehicles travelling east on Parallel Street
- Chain link fence on Jefferson Avenue is not up to date for modern crash tested barriers





View depicts retaining wall supporting Jefferson Ave., crack at concrete bridge abutment, narrow and dark underpass, and lack of lane striping for vehicular guidance.



How did we get here?

November

2022

Design Notice to Proceed Issued (NTP)

(MassDOT contracts Benesch as Design Consultant.)

March

2023

Began Field Investigations & Survey

(Benesch coordinates ground survey, site investigation and geotechnical exploration and sampling.)

June

2023

Pre-25% Design Submittal to MassDOT and City of Salem

(Benesch prepares preliminary design of two alternatives for the replacement of the Jefferson Ave. Bridge.)

November

2023

Bridge Type Selection Worksheet submitted to MassDOT and City of Salem

(Benesch prepares written report which outlines design intent, with ballpark cost estimate for the design alternatives.)

February

2024

Public Information Meeting

(MassDOT/Salem informs stakeholders of the project intent and the two design alternatives to receive feedback.
Feedback will be used to assist MassDOT/Salem to select a preferred Alternative Design.)





What do we want to accomplish?

Project Goals

Replace Structurally Deficient Bridge

- Improve accessibility to the west side of Parallel Street
 - Improve vertical and horizontal clearance

- Accelerated Construction Techniques
 - Shorter construction duration than conventional construction
 - Minimize impacts to traveling public and abutters
- Traffic and Complete Street Improvements



Proposed Improvements

Add buffered bike lanes to Jefferson Avenue

Repair existing retaining walls

Improve barriers on existing retaining walls

 Improve access to Jefferson Avenue for property owners on Parallel Street





What alternatives were considered?

Alternative 1


- Replace the existing bridge with a new bridge
 - Minimum vertical clearance raised to approximately 9'
 - Widen Parallel Street under the bridge to a minimum of 20'

Alternative 2

- Reroute Parallel Street
 - Remove vertical and horizontal clearance restrictions
 - Reduce construction duration and disruptions
 - Parallel Street underpass will be permanently closed with extensions of the existing retaining walls
 - Existing bridge will be removed and replaced with structural backfill




Alternative 1 – Phase 1



- Jefferson Avenue and
 Parallel Street remain open
 during construction of
 temporary access road
- Relocate utilities as necessary




Alternative 1 – Phase 2



- Partial closure of Jefferson Avenue
- Single lane alternating traffic during construction
- Temporary traffic signals and lane restriping used to control traffic flow
- Parallel St. Underpass temporarily closed



Alternative 1 – Phase 3




- Partial closure of Jefferson

 Avenue
- Single lane alternating traffic during construction
- Temporary traffic signals and lane restriping used to control traffic flow
- Parallel St. Underpass temporarily closed




Alternative 2 – Phase 1




- Traffic maintained on
 Parallel Street and
 Jefferson Avenue during
 construction of access road
- Utilities impacted by construction relocated at this time.

Alternative 2 – Phase 3



- Alternating one-way traffic on Jefferson Avenue during bridge removal and retaining wall construction
- Temporary traffic signals and lane restriping used to control traffic flow
- Bridge structure replaced with retaining walls and structural backfill
- Parallel St. Underpass permanently closed






How will your property be impacted?

Easements

- Possible temporary or permanent easements for construction of this project.
- City of Salem will reach out to affected property owners as design advances.
- Potential sidewalk easements for retaining wall rehabilitation and modification.





Preliminary Right of Way (ROW) discussion Public Information Meeting

- City of Salem is responsible for acquiring all necessary rights in public land for design, construction, and implementation of this project.
 - Fee takings, permanent easements and/or temporary construction easements may be required.
- Affected property owners will be contacted by personnel from the City of Salem or consultants representing the responsible agency.
 - Property owners are protected under Massachusetts General Laws, primarily Chapter 79.
- Preliminary ROW drawings, once prepared, will be available for public review and comment at a later time.

At this stage of design, the Right of Way process has not been finalized. This meeting is an opportunity for the public to comment on any impacts to properties.
