



Concord – Alternatives to Improve the Route 2 Concord Rotary

What is happening?

The Massachusetts Department of Transportation – Highway Division will be holding a Public Information Meeting (PIM) regarding MassDOT Project No. 602091, Improvements & Upgrades to Concord Rotary. This meeting is open to everyone and will provide the public with the opportunity to review and express thoughts on the alternatives being advanced to improve traffic operations, improve safety, and provide multi-modal transportation, including bicycle and pedestrian accommodations.

How will this affect you?

The proposed project has advanced four alternatives for the improvements to the Route 2 Concord Rotary and Elm Street intersections to address traffic and safety concerns at these locations. Three of the alternatives propose a grade-separated interchange for the Concord Rotary and one alternative proposes an at-grade solution. All four of the alternatives include replacing the bridge structure that carries Route 2 over the Assabet River and improvements to the Elm Street intersection at the Baker Avenue Extension.
