



Natick - Route 27 and Route 9 Bridge Replacement and Interchange Improvements

Public Information Meeting

What is Happening?

The Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) will host an In-Person Public Information Meeting to present a status update for the Route 27 and Route 9 Bridge Replacement and Interchange Improvements Project in Natick, MA.

The purpose of this meeting is to update the public on the status of the bridge replacement project and interchange improvements.

The project team will present information related to the progress and schedule of construction, after which attendees will have the opportunity to ask questions and provide comments.

How will This Affect You?

This project replaces the structurally deficient bridge carrying North Main Street (Route 27) over Worcester Street (Route 9) and reconfigures the interchange into a modified Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI). Improvements will enhance safety, reduce congestion, and upgrade bicycle and pedestrian facilities using separated shared use paths and sidewalks.

The project also includes transit stop upgrades, sidewalk reconstruction, drainage improvements, traffic signals, utility relocations, lighting, signing, and landscaping.
