

Route 114 Danvers/Peabody Long-Term Improvements Study Public Meeting #1

What is happening?

MassDOT will hold a Public Information Meeting for the Route 114 Danvers/Peabody Long-Term Improvements Study in-person on August 1, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. at the Peter A. Torigian Senior Center, Peabody. This study follows Tier 2 construction improvements carried out by the MassDOT Highway Division.

At this meeting, the study team will share an overview of the study's background, present existing conditions work, and solicit feedback. Accessibility accommodations and language services will be provided free of charge, upon request, as available.

The Route 114 Danvers/Peabody Long-Term Safety Improvements Study is intended to develop and analyze long-term potential changes to the Route 114 corridor within the Town of Danvers and the City of Peabody. The study will analyze the possibility of installing a median, among other safety measures, and ways to improve the public realm in the area. MassDOT will work with legislators, municipalities and stakeholders to develop recommendations for this effort.
