

Public Informational Meeting, Somerset Route 6 Intersection Project

What is happening?

A Public Informational Meeting will be hosted in the Somerset Public Library to present the design for the proposed project in Somerset, MA.

How will this affect you?

The proposed project consists of improving safety at the intersection of Route 6 and Lees River Avenue. The intersection was ranked #43 in the Top 200 Crash Clusters List of 2015-2017.

A roundabout design is proposed at this intersection, replacing the existing signalized intersection with one shared through-left lane and one shared through-right lane and a single receiving lane.

In addition, the project aims to enhance bicycle and pedestrian facilities, as sidewalk facilities are sporadic within project limits and no bicycle facilities are currently present.

There are anticipated Right-of-Way impacts on Route 6 associated with this project.
