

Bridge Street and South Main Street Bridge Replacements Public Information Meeting

What is happening?

The purpose of this Public Information Meeting is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the Bridge Street and South Main Street Bridge Replacements project in Williamsburg, MA. Public comment and concerns are being solicited and will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

How will this affect you?

The existing bridges are structurally deficient and need to be replaced. To minimize traffic disruptions during construction, one bridge at a time will be closed and reconstructed with all traffic detoured over the other bridge. In the final condition, the traffic configuration will be changed into a one-way, single lane loop between the Bridge Street bridge, South Main Street, and the South Main Street bridge at the intersection at Route 9 (Main Street). A shared use path will be constructed along South Main Street between Route 9 (Main Street) and the intersection of South Main Street and Bridge Street.
