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



Construction and Staging Update

Construction Overview


Original project timeline – approximately 4 years

- Daytime work schedule
 - Typical work hours 7:00 AM to 3:30 PM
 - May vary between 5:00 AM and 7:00 PM
- Occasional night and weekend work
- Maintain emergency services

Mitigation of Construction Impacts

- Major earthwork operations will be within confined work zones
- Minimize construction vehicle turning movements
- Travel speeds reduced through work zones for safety
- Water spray for dust suppression









Major Milestones Achieved

Utilities

- Early utility poles relocation
- 3 years reduced to 2 years eliminating a phase

3 Culverts (Across Route 20 Roadway) Replaced




2024 Temporary Lane Closures

1 Lane in Each Direction, March 4 through November 2024

Changed from what we previously presented

- One lane from Richardson Corner Rd to Route 12
- Maintaining existing turn lanes at Route 56, Route 12, and Richardson Corner Rd
- U-turns allowed at Richardson Corner Rd, Route 56, and Route 12
- Left turns into and out of other side streets or driveways restricted due to barrier
- Will maintain access to local businesses
- Off season will return to 4 lanes throughout corridor





2024 Temporary Lane Closures - Benefits

Schedule Benefits

- Expedited construction timeline project will be completed 10 months earlier than originally planned
- Project will be substantially complete in 2025 with only finish work and cleanup remaining (subject to weather and other factors)

Safety Benefits

- Use of a longer-term setup with barrier will provide a buffer between the work zone and lanes open to travel
 - Increases safety for construction workers and the traveling public
 - The corridor is narrow and speeds on the corridor are high (the work zone speed limit is not always followed)






Route 20 Construction on the North (Westbound) Side, March – July 2024








Stage 2 Configuration

Route 20 Construction on the South (Eastbound) Side, July – November 2024





Wide Loads Prohibited from Work Zone

- Restriction prohibits vehicles carrying wide loads over 8 ft 6 in on Route 20 between Route 12 and Richardson Corner Road
- In place 24/7 during lane closures
- The project team will continue to coordinate with businesses inside the project limits






Current Work Activities

Roadway Widening and Infrastructure

- Current work activities:
 - Utilities
 - Roadway widening
 - Retaining walls
- Why: Necessary to widening corridor and alignment configuration
- Anticipated construction season completion: November 2024
- Construction work hours:
 - Monday through Friday from 7:00 AM to 3:30 PM,
 - May vary between 5:00 AM and 7:00 PM
 - With occasional night and weekend work
- Traffic impacts: Traffic configuration reduced to 1 lane in each direction from Richardson Corner Rd to Route 12
