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



Construction Timeline

Construction Overview

Original project timeline – approximately 4 years

By completing two phases of construction in 2024, the project will be substantially complete in Fall 2025

- Daytime work schedule
 - Typical work hours 7:00 AM to 3:30 PM
 - May vary between 5:00 AM and 7:00 PM
- Occasional night and weekend work
- Maintain emergency services
- Posted speeds reduced through work zones for safety







Major Milestones Achieved

Construction Completion:

- Roadway widening
- French and Little River Bridges
- 14 retaining walls
- 8 Miles Underground utilities and stormwater controls
- Precast median barrier (10,000 linear feet)

Returned to 4 lanes of traffic in 2024





2025 Construction: Phase 3

- Installation of remaining sidewalk and granite curb
- Installation of remaining fence and guardrail
- Wetland replication
- Landscaping slope seeding and plantings
- Final Paving
- Completion of new roundabout at Oxbow Road





2025 Construction: Anticipated Traffic Impacts

- Temporary single lane closures in areas of work
 - Both daytime and nighttime lane closures are anticipated
- Weekend detours for side roads for construction of the roundabout and intersections
 - Route 20 through traffic to be maintained
- Nighttime paving

Wide Loads Prohibited from Work Zone on Route 20

- Restriction prohibits vehicles carrying wide loads over 8 feet, 6 inches (8'-6")
- In place 24 hours per day, seven days per week
- The project team will continue to coordinate with businesses inside the project limits
