




Bridge Locations

Bridge Deficiencies

- Bridge decks are in fair condition but are continuing to decline
- Steel superstructure paint system has failed, and the steel is corroding
- Bridge substructures are declining in condition and in need of repair
- Bridge bearings and joints are failing
- Substandard guardrails and approach barriers



Project Goals and Objectives

- Improve Safety
- Improve Accessibility
- Bridge Preservation / Rehabilitation







Bridge Preservation

- Replace the bridge decks
- Clean, paint, and repair the structural steels
- Repair the existing bridge substructures
- Replace the bridge bearings and joints
- Construct new crash-tested bridge barriers
- Reconstruct the approach roadway to provide seamless transitions







Upcoming Work Activities

Construction Overview

- Structural bridge work at all locations with some roadway work at the Bridge approaches.
- Travel speeds reduced through work zones for safety
- Water spray for dust suppression
- Continuous noise monitoring and control measures



Construction Sequence

- Mobilization
- Preliminary Work
- Removals
- Replacement Work
- Finishes



Construction Work Hours

- Daytime work schedule
 - Typical work hours 7:00am to 3:30 pm
 - May vary between 5:00am and 7:00pm
- Overnight work schedule:
 - Typical work hours 8:00pm to 5:00 am
- Occasional weekend work (Daytime Saturdays and Overnight Sundays).



Expected Work Activities

- What: Contractor to start shielding and lagging activities on the existing bridges. Tree trimming and clearing activities to support installation of new Utility poles.
- Why: Set protective measures prior to bridge deck demolition and paint removal on the steel beams.
- When: Starting May 2024
 - East St. (Duxbury)
 - George St. (Mansfield)
 - River St. (Plymouth)










What are the traffic impacts?

Duxbury – East Street over Route 3


- Long-term Roadway closure
 at East St. with detour starting
 May 2024 for a total duration of
 12 months during construction
 of the Bridge.
- No pedestrians or bicyclists will be allowed across the bridge
- Proposed detour route to
 bypass the Bridge is 4.8 miles






Mansfield – George St over Copeland Drive

- Long-term Roadway
 closure with detour starting
 June 2024 for a total
 duration of 8 months during
 construction of the Bridge.
- No pedestrians or bicyclists will be allowed across the bridge
- Proposed detour route is 0.9 miles





Staged Construction Locations



- Locations starting in 2024:
 - River Street over Plimoth Patuxet Highway (Plymouth)
- Locations starting in 2025:
 - Jordan Rd. over Route 3 (Plymouth)
 - Pickens St. over Route 140 (Lakeville)
 - Charge Pond Rd. over Route 25 (Wareham)
- Stage 1: One lane of alternating traffic will be in place for construction and a temporary traffic light will be used to alternate traffic.
- Stage 2: Alternate access to be accommodated on opposite side of the Bridge, with final configuration under development.

Local roadway users

- Changeable message signs
- Install construction signage throughout the corridor
- Announcements for detours
- Maintain access to abutters
- Maintain traffic signal operation

Regional roadway users

- Install Portable Message Boards informing motorists of travel times
- Portable Message Boards will be installed at decision-making points
