

March

Design 75% complete and project presented at Public Informational Meeting

Existing Deficiencies

- Functionally obsolete bridges
- Substandard shoulder widths
- Substandard vertical clearance

- Replace Functionally
 Obsolete Bridges
- Reconstruct Franklin Street
- Update drainage system
 and water quality treatment
 within Rt. 3 median







Project Goals and Objectives (cont.)

- Widen shoulders on Route 3
- Provide widening for future lane
- Reconstruct pavement

What is the construction approach?

Construction Sequence

- Project Design
- Construction Stage 1
 - Demolition & Construction of the first half of the Route 3NB/SB Bridges over Franklin Street
- Construction Stage 2
 - Demolition & Construction of the second half of the Route 3NB/SB Bridges over Franklin Street
- Final Stage
 - Milling of Route 3 NB/SB, Superpave, Pavement Markings & Rumble Strips





Construction Overview - Schedule and Details

Overall project timeline – approximately 3 years

- Daytime work schedule
 - Typical work hours 7:00am to 3:30pm
 - May vary between 5:00am and 7:00pm
- Occasional night and weekend work
- Maintain emergency services.

Construction

- Construction operations will be within confined Work Zones
- Safely move construction vehicles to/from Work Zones
- Advisory to recommend reduced speeds through Work Zones



Temporary Traffic Control – Franklin Street

- Maintain 2-way traffic during bridge construction
- Short term closure/detour during demolition of existing bridge
- Short term closure/detour during erection of new bridge beams
- Maintain one-way alternating traffic during Franklin St reconstruction



Temporary Traffic Control – Route 3 Expressway

- Implement Lane Shifts to create work zones
- Maintain 2 lanes of traffic in each direction during peak hours
- Single Lane Closures during overnight hours for material deliveries, as required

- Why: Facilitate Tree Clearing of Median, Patrial Demolition of Bridge, Excavation for new Foundations, and Partial Construction of new Bridge
- When: June 2024 September 2025
