



- Narrow Shoulders

Proposed work will integrate with future I-95 corridor projects.








Project Location – I-95 Northbound Addition of 4th Lane





I-95 Northbound- Existing Lane Drop - Reading







I-95 Northbound- Proposed Lane Drop Elimination - Reading












I-95 Northbound Typical Section










I-95 Northbound Typical Section






How will the road user be affected?
