PROPOSAL: The purpose of the project is to insure the operational use and safety of the I-93 Viaduct structure. The proposed project consists of cleaning, repairing and painting of several areas of structural steel superstructure; repairing deteriorated area of concrete substructure; removal of salt piles under the viaduct to allow the repair of the substructure in this area; replacing the failing bridge deck joints; and implementation of associated traffic management which includes temporary detours and lane closures.

A secure right-of-way is not necessary for this project.
