## Route 6 (Scenic Highway) Corridor Improvements **Bourne, MA**

## What is happening?

A Live Virtual Public Information Hearing will be hosted on the MassDOT website below to present the design for the Route 6 Corridor Improvement project in Bourne, MA.

## How will this affect you?

The proposed project consists of the widening of Route 6 (Scenic Highway) between Edgehill Road and Nightingale Road. The widened roadway will include the addition of a raised center median between eastbound and westbound traffic, improvements to lane and shoulders widths and cross slope improvements on curves on the roadway. The project will incorporate a 10 foot wide shared use path between both intersections that will be physically separated from roadway traffic. Drainage improvements for treatment and catchment include a new swale along the westbound shoulder and new underground drainage.
