MassEVolves is a program which supports and publicly recognizes organizations who take specific steps to encourage greater electric vehicle adoption, consistent with statewide clean air goals. Participating companies pledge to take action on programs that include installing EV charging stations at the workplace, promoting zero emissions vehicles with employees and the public, and reviewing their own fleet of vehicles for opportunities to convert to electric or plug in hybrid vehicles.

Get Started:

- 1. Create your ZEV Action Team to develop and implement ZEV strategies
- 2. Submit your company's pledge to create and implement a ZEV Action Plan
- 3. Develop and submit your ZEV Action Plan within four months of submitting your pledge
- 4. Report on your progress

 on implementation within a year of submittal

Once your pledge is submitted, participants have the opportunity to be recognized by MassEVolves through:

- website acknowledgment
- regular outreach events
- annual recognition event at the Massachusetts Statehouse
