The Executive Office of Health and Human Services (EOHHS) is the single state agency that administers MassHealth, the Medicaid program in Massachusetts. EOHHS has contracted with PCG to provide asset verification services for certain MassHealth applicants. The change from a manual to an electronic process for asset verification is to comply with federal law and a directive from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, a federal government agency. Starting in November 2016, EOHHS will conduct asset verifications electronically through PCG's web-based system. However, EOHHS will continue to determine eligibility for Medicaid applicants.
