The Massachusetts Community Living Initiative is a commitment to further grow the state's ability to serve people with disabilities or who are age 65 or older in the community and as an alternative to receiving services in a nursing facility or other institutional setting.



Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Waivers

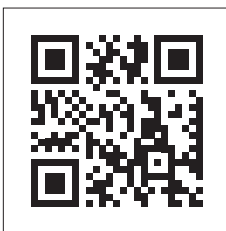
These programs are designed to meet the needs of MassHealth members who prefer to get long-term-care services and supports in their home or community, rather than in an institutional setting.

Massachusetts currently operates 10 HCBS waivers, each for a specific population.

- Children's Autism Spectrum Disorder Waiver

- Moving Forward Plan Residential Supports Waiver
- Traumatic Brain Injury Waiver

Money Follows the Person Demonstration (MFP Demo)

This program is available to MassHealth members in nursing facilities, hospitals for chronic disease or rehabilitation, or other institutional settings who wish to return to the community. The MFP Demo can help members transition back to the community with the necessary supports and services. Members can participate in both the MFP Demo and an HCBS waiver at the same time.

The MFP Demo can help members with the following:

- Find accessible and affordable housing
- Pay first month's rent, security deposits, and overdue utility bills
- Pay for moving expenses, home modifications, and home furnishings
- Pay for dishes, pots and pans, and other household goods
- Pay for other needed items to establish a community residence
- And more
