## On a good note...



- We appreciate the partnership with the Implementation Council as we've gotten One Care back onto stable footing and focused on smart, sustainable growth strategies
  - Targeted outreach mailings this Fall contributed to 800+ self-selection enrollments for December 1, 2016 – this is the highest self-selection volume we've seen since the beginning of the Demonstration
- CommonHealth in One Care
  - November 2016 1115 Waiver approval now provides federal match for CommonHealth members once they turn 65 (previously 100% state-funded)
  - CommonHealth members enrolled in One Care will soon be able to stay in One Care when they turn 65
- 2017 Enrollment Strategies:
  - Additional targeted outreach (mailings, education, events)
  - Next quarterly passive effective April 1, 2017
  - Online enrollment form
- We look forward to partnering with the Implementation Council in the new term to continue to strengthen and grow One Care
