Ed Lima's Wine & Spirits Inc. d/b/a Village Package Store (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("Commission" or "ABCC") held a hearing on Tuesday, August 13, 2019, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator Binienda's Report.

FACTS

- 1. On Wednesday, May 15, 2019, at approximately 4:32 p.m., Investigators Velez and Binienda ("Investigators") investigated the business of Ed Lima's Wine & Spirits Inc. d/b/a Village Package Store.
- 2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, an 18-pack of Bud Light beer for seventeen dollars and eighty-nine cents (\$17.89). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
- 3. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 15 since 2007.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21). Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for a period of one (1) day which will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
