DECISION

TOKYO RESTAURANT, INC. DBA TOKYO RESTUARANT 143 FAIRHAVEN ROAD MATTAPOISETT, MA 02739

Tokyo Restaurant, Inc. dba Tokyo Restaurant (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("the Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, August 16, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Jamie Binienda's Compliance Check Field Report.

- 2. Compliance Check Field Report of Investigator Jamie Binienda.

FACTS

- On, May 20, 2011 at approximately 3:50 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation Tokyo Restaurant, Inc. dba Tokyo Restaurant.
- The underage operative did not pay for the alcoholic beverage but took possession of a Bud Light.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34. The Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
