FINAL DECISION-ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter concerns an appeal by John Grenier of J. M. Grenier Associates of a superseding order of conditions issued by the Department of Environmental Protection under M.G.L. c. 131, §40, the Wetlands Protection Act. The petitioner filed a motion to dismiss, which is unopposed.

The petitioner submits that this matter is now moot and should be dismissed. According to the petitioner, it revised the project and filed another permit application. The Shrewsbury Conservation Commission denied the revised project. The DEP, however, issued a superseding order of conditions allowing it. That superseding order of conditions is now final.

Accordingly, this appeal is **DISMISSED** as moot. *Matter of Howland*, Docket No. 99-113, Final Decision – Order of Dismissal (January 5, 2005). The superseding order of conditions appealed from is vacated.

Reconsideration and Appeal

The parties to this proceeding are notified of their right to file a Motion for Reconsideration of this Decision. Such a motion must be filed with the Docket Clerk and served on all parties
