Saturday 1:00–3:00 p.m. October 4	Moulton’s Castle Have you ever wondered why there is a Castle Hill at Maudslay? Learn about the site of Civil War veteran Henry Moulton’s home on this hike, approximately 2.5 miles with elevation change and some challenging footing, moderately difficult. For ages 8 & up.
Sunday 10:00–11:30 a.m. October 5	Nice’n Easy Hike Join the park interpreter for a basic recreational hike to explore the diverse landscape on a variety of trails through different areas of the park. For all ages.
Sunday 2:00–4:00 p.m. October 5	Interpretation Station: Mammals Join the park interpreter at this station where certain animal pelts & skull replicas will be on display, and to understand more about their characteristics, habitat and diet. Check the board at each entrance to find the location. For all ages.
Monday 10:00–11:30 a.m. October 13	Fall Findings Many changes occur as our world moves from Summer into Fall. Join the park interpreter for this fun program that focuses on finding the changes with nature in Autumn. For: ages 6 & up.
Thursday 9:30–10:30 a.m. October 2 & 9	Morning Saunter Join the park interpreter for a leisurely walk through Maudslay. This program combines exercise with resource discovery and is slow paced particularly for seniors. For all ages.
