Full Alley Closure June 2022 through May 2022



As Construction activities progress on the Lemuel Shattuck Hospital's move to the East Newton Pavilion (ENP) at 88 East Newton Street, work within the state-Property to adjacent parking spaces during this owned alley on this property will require the alleys full closure beginning in June of 2022 and will continue through May 2023. The planned construction activities require the closure of the alley to pedestrian and vehicular traffic to insure workers and abutter safety. Some special and limited access accommodation can be considered when possible, and with advance notice and approval by the contractor.

Construction activities anticipated during this phase will include replacing old storm drain lines, Improving utilities infrastructure, installing new facades, new windows, and repaying of the street.

In order to ensure worker and abutter safety. Emergency Pedestrian Egress only, will be provided during active construction hours (Monday-Friday, 7am to 5pm) pedestrian passage within Emergency Egress area during off hours is not encouraged and

This required alley closure during construction will prevent access over the West Newton Pavilion phase. Abutters whose parking is impacted by this closure will be contacted separately regarding alternate parking arrangements

We thank you for your patience and consideration as we work to improve this infrastructure critical to the rehabilitation of the East Newton Pavilion and the new Lemuel Shattuck Hospital.
