The Tentative Decisions in Cranberry Point and Medway Grid are limited in focus to a single common legal issue: whether the Siting Board has the statutory authority to approve or reject Battery Energy Storage Systems pursuant to G.L. c. 164, § 69J<sup>1</sup>/4, which pertains to the Siting Board's "generating facility" approval authority.

The Energy Facilities Siting Board ("Siting Board") will conduct a remote Siting Board meeting on Wednesday, May 10, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. The purpose of the Siting Board meeting is to listen to comments, deliberate and vote on whether to approve, approve with conditions or amendments, or reject the two Tentative Decisions issued by the Siting Board in the above referenced cases.
