

MINUTES

May 19, 2025

A Hybrid Meeting of the Commissioners of the Cape Cod Mosquito Control Project (CCMCP) was held on May 19, 2025. In participation was: Supt.

Gabrielle Sakolsky-Hoopers, Assistant Superintendent Barton Morris, Entomologist Aubrey Paolino, Chairman J. Gregory Milne, Vice-Chairman Rodney Collins, Secretary James Quirk and Commissioner Emily Beebe.

The following remote meeting declaration was read into the minutes:
Cape Cod Mosquito Control Project Board of Commissioners is Meeting remotely pursuant to legislative authorization extending the remote meeting provisions of the Open Meeting Law through June 30, 2027, as signed into law by Governor Healey on March 28, 2025.

Vice-Chairman made a motion to approve the minutes of April 28, 2025. Secretary Quirk 2nd the motion and it passed unanimously by way of roll call.

Supt. Sakolsky reminded the Board of the requirement to complete the annual mandatory online training before the end of this month.

The Board discussed new fiscal year cost of living adjustments (COLA). Vice-Chairman Collins made a motion to authorize a 3% COLA salary increase to all employees in accordance with the Superintendent's recommendation, effective July 1, 2025. Secretary Quirk 2nd the motion and it passed unanimously by way of roll call.


Supt. Sakolsky updated the Board on various salt marsh restoration projects that CCMCP is collaborating with throughout the Cape.

The Board was informed of the next State Reclamation and Mosquito Control Board meeting scheduled for May 21, 2025. Fiscal year 2026 budgets will be voted on for certification.

In the field, conditions are drying in many areas. Crews will continue to monitor tidal flooding. Surveillance trapping has begun, and DPH will commence arbovirus testing the week of June 16th.

The next meeting was scheduled for June 24, 2025 at 2PM.

There being no further business, Vice-Chairman Collins made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Secretary Quirk and approved unanimously by way of roll call.
