May Precipitation To Date






Accumulated Precipitation (inches) May 01, 2025 to May 18, 2025






Central/Western MA: 4-6+"


Eastern MA: 2-4+"

East/Southeast MA: 0.5" to 2" above normal

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
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Since February 1st and November 1st

Last ~3.5 Months (02/01-05/18)

- Near to above normal for most of MA (80-120%)
- Worcester County well above normal (120-160%)
- Pockets below normal (60-80%) Cape/Islands


Precipitation Percent of Normal February 01, 2025 to May 18, 2025



Last ~6.5 Months (11/01-05/18)

- Mostly near normal
- Localized 60-80% western MA, Cape, MVY
- Nantucket 40-60%

7 Day Precipitation Forecast


Through Sunday May 18th



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- I-I.5" for most of MA
- 1.5+ for Berkshire County
- Generally unsettled with multiple rounds of precipitation Thursday-Sunday




Outlook: May 26th - June 1st




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Odds favor near to above normal precipitation and near-below normal temperatures









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Leaning Above Normal Precipitation




Leaning Above Normal Temperatures



Outlook for Jun, July, August



Odds favor above normal precipitation and above normal temperatures through August





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May to Date: Above Normal Precipitation for Most of Massachusetts

- Central/Western MA: 4-6+" (2-4" above normal)
- Eastern MA: 2-4+" (0.5-2" above normal)
- Cape/Islands: I-2" (Within 0.5-1" of normal)

Longer Range Precipitation Departures:

- 3-month and 6-month departures near normal for most of the state
- Sections of western MA, Cape, and Islands below normal (40-80% of normal)

Outlook:

- I to 1.5" of new precipitation possible through Sunday evening with the best chances for western MA
- Leaning toward near-above normal precipitation through June 1st
- Odds favor above normal precipitation through August
