Applicants must be at least 17 years of age. Education must be a High School or Trade School Diploma, the equivalent or high school seniors graduating in the current school year. Applicants must be physically able to perform the work of the Trade, must take and pass a mechanical aptitude test and show a valid ID.

The Committee will interview each applicant who meets all basic requirements. The interview team will consider reliability, interest, attitude, judgement, results of math test, and cooperation, as well as other traits. All applications will be received without regard to race, color, religion, national origin, or sex.
