ORDER RE#1: The defendant has filed a petition for interlocutory relief pursuant to G. L. c. 231, s. 118 (first para.) asking me, as single justice, to reverse the portion of the Suffolk County Superior Court's 3/21/2022 order granting the Commonwealth's motion to strike Defenses 30-33 and 35 in ExxonMobil's Amended Complaint. I have reviewed the comprehensive and thoughtful briefing of both parties, the supporting documents, the case law and legal authorities cited by both parties, and the judge's comprehensive memorandum and analysis. Based on that review and the record before me, I discern no clear error of law or abuse of discretion. See *Jet-Line Services, Inc. v. Board of Selectmen of Stoughton*, 25 Mass. App. Ct. 645, 646 (1988). Accordingly, the petition is denied. (Neyman, J.) Notice/attest/Krupp,J
