


### April Precipitation & Departures



#### Precipitation


Accumulated Precipitation (inches) April 01, 2025 to May 01, 2025

Precipitation Departure from Normal (inches) April 01, 2025 to May 01, 2025




Central/Western MA: I-2+ inches above normal East/Southeast MA: 0.5" to 1.5" below normal


### 3 and 6 Month Percent of Normal



### Last 3 Months (Feb-Apr)


- Near normal (80-120%) across eastern/southeastern MA
- Pockets below normal (40-80%) Cape/Islands






### Last 6 Months (Nov-Apr)

- Mostly near normal
- Localized 60-80% western MA, Cape, MVY
- Nantucket 40-60%





### Generally within I degree of normal




## 7 Day Precipitation Forecast


- Includes Tuesday/Wednesday Precip

- Additional precip Friday-Saturday




### Outlook: May 11th - May 15th



### Odds favor below normal precipitation and above normal temperatures






### Outlook: May 17th – May 30th

60-70% chance for above normal temperatures











April: Near normal temperatures and below to above normal precipitation

- Above normal precipitation for Western, Central, and eastern MA (1-2" above normal)
- Below normal precipitation for southeast MA, Cape, and Islands (0.5 to 1.5" below normal)

#### Longer Range Precipitation Departures:

- 3-month and 6-month departures near normal for most of the state
- Sections of western MA, Cape, and Islands below normal (40-80% of normal)

#### Outlook:

- I to 2" of new precipitation possible through next Tuesday with the best chances away from southeast MA
- Leaning toward below normal precipitation for the second week of May
- Odds favor above normal precipitation through July
