## Introduction

The Town of Maynard is located in Middlesex County, Massachusetts, just 22 miles west of Boston. The Town has a population of 10,526, a median household income of \$90,134<sup>2</sup>, and was incorporated in 1871. Maynard is rich in history and well-known for its many recreational opportunities including walking tours, open spaces, and public trails. Like many Massachusetts towns, Maynard strives to communicate regularly with residents and provide useful information in a user-friendly format. In alignment with these efforts the Town of Maynard pledged to implement technology best practices to increase government transparency. Town officials received a Community Compact grant to implement an Open Budget solution to give citizens access to the Town's budgetary information in an easily understandable format.


