CONSENT AGREEMENT

The Board of Registration in Pharmacy ("Board") and Mayra A. Ventura ("Registrant"), a pharmacy technician trainee who has applied for registration by the Board as a pharmacy technician, do hereby stipulate and agree that the following information shall be entered into and become a permanent part of the file of the Registrant which is maintained by the Board:

- 1. The parties enter into this Consent Agreement ("Agreement") in order to resolve disputed matters arising out of a complaint pending before the Board regarding Registrant as Docket No. PHA20110048 ("Complaint").
- 2. The Registrant acknowledges that she was employed to perform pharmacy technician trainee duties at Tufts Medical Center located at 800 Washington Street in Boston, Massachusetts for a total number of hours in excess of the authorized maximum 1000 hours of employment as a pharmacy technician trainee, in violation of 247 CMR 8.03(3).
- 3. Accordingly, the Registrant and the Board agree to the following:
 - a. That the conduct described in Paragraph 2 above warrants disciplinary action by the Board for employment as pharmacy technician trainee in excess of the maximum number of hours permitted by 247 CMR 8.03(3);
 - b. The Board will approve Registrant's applicant for licensure as a Pharmacy Technician (Pharmacy Technician Registration No. PT13577); and

The Board will REPRIMAND Registrant's Pharmacy Technician Registration.

- 4. The Agreement and its contents shall become a part of the records maintained by the Board, and as such, are public records subject to disclosure to the public, other licensing boards, and the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy.
- 5. The Board agrees that in return for the Registrant's execution of this Agreement, the Board will not advance the prosecution of the Registrant pursuant to the Complaint; any and all other rights of the Board to take action within the scope of its authority are expressly reserved.

- 6. The Registrant understands and agrees that her decision to enter into this Agreement and to accept the terms and conditions herein described is a final act and is not subject to reconsideration or judicial review.
- 7. The Registrant states that she has used legal counsel in connection with her decision to enter into this Agreement or, if she did not, that she had an opportunity to do so and that her decision to enter into this Agreement was made of her own free will.
- 8. Registrant certifies that she has read this document entitled "Consent Agreement". The Registrant understands that, by executing this Agreement, she is waiving her right to a formal hearing at which she would possess the rights to confront and cross-examine witnesses, to call witnesses, to present evidence, to testify on her own behalf, to contest the allegations, to present oral argument, to appeal to the court in the event of an adverse ruling, and all other rights set forth in the State Administrative Procedure Act, G.L. c. 30A, and the Standard Adjudicatory Rules of Practice and Procedure, 801 CMR 1.01 et seq.
