Briefly describe the nature and objectives of the proposed Material Change, including any exchange of funds between the parties (such as any arrangement in which one party agrees to furnish the other party with a discount, rebate, or any other type of refund or remuneration in exchange for, or in any way related to, the provision of Health Care Services) and whether any changes in Health Care Services are anticipated in connection with the proposed Material Change;

The objective of the proposed Material Change is to create the level of economic and clinical integration required to establish a new health care delivery system in Eastern Massachusetts — one that is well positioned to provide consumers with a high-value market alternative to help the Commonwealth lower health care costs.

CareGroup, Inc. (the parent of Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center, Inc. (BIDMC), which includes Beth Israel Deaconess Hospital-Milton, Inc., Beth Israel Deaconess Hospital - Needham, Inc., and Beth Israel Deaconess Hospital - Plymouth, Inc., New England Baptist Hospital, and Mount Aubum Hospital). Lahey Health System, Inc. (LHS) (the parent of Lahey Clinic Hospital, Inc., Northeast Hospital Corp., and Winchester Hospital), and SRHS, together will create a new, non-profit charitable corporation (NewCo), which will serve as a comprehensive, distributed, and high-value health care system in Eastern Massachusetts.

NewCo will become the sole corporate member of (i) each hospital within CareGroup, LHS, and SRHS; and (ii) a Clinically Integrated Network (NewCo CIN), which will be the sole corporate member of Beth Israel Deaconess Physician Organization, LLC dib/a Beth Israel Deaconess Care Organization, Lahey Clinical Performance Network, LLC and Lahey Clinical Performance Accountable Care Organization, LLC. Mount Aubum Cambridge Independent Practice Association, Inc. will remain an independent corporate entity, but will participate in the design, management, and governance of, and become a participating provider in, NewCo CIN.

No funds will be exchanged among the parties as part of this transaction. There are no specific changes to Health Care Services planned as part of this affiliation at this time.

15. Briefly describe the anticipated impact of the proposed Material Change, including but not limited to any anticipated impact on reimbursement rates, care referral patterns, access to needed services, and/or quality of care:

NewCo providers are among the lowest cost relative to market peers. Bringing these providers together offers a procompetitive, high-quality, lower cost option that will benefit consumers and payers in the Commonwealth. The establishment of NewCo CIN allows NewCo to effectively manage total medical expenses and improve access, quality, and coordination of medical and behavioral health care. Through this organizational structure, NewCo will achieve the level of economic and clinical integration regulred to compete effectively and thereby help the Commonwealth meet its cost containment goals.

NewCo alms to positively impact the average cost of care by attracting patients to its lower cost provider network. As a financially integrated provider network, NewCo, along with NewCo CIN, will be better able to attract such patients and provide the right level of care within the system. The geographic coverage of NewCo and NewCo CIN will improve access for consumers to medical and behavioral health providers within a well-managed, integrated system of care that can be the foundation for tlered or narrow network insurance products. In addition, NewCo and NewCo CIN will build on the legacy of quality improvement pursued by each of the parties through improved access to patient information and the sharing of best practices, evidence-based medicine, and quality improvement infrastructure.
