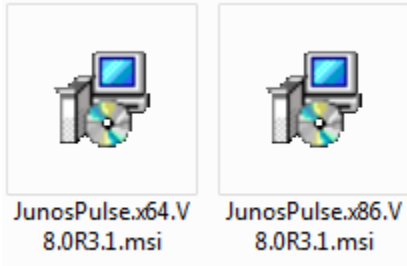
Outside Vendor Computer Requirement and Connectivity Process

MDOR VPN Setup Procedures

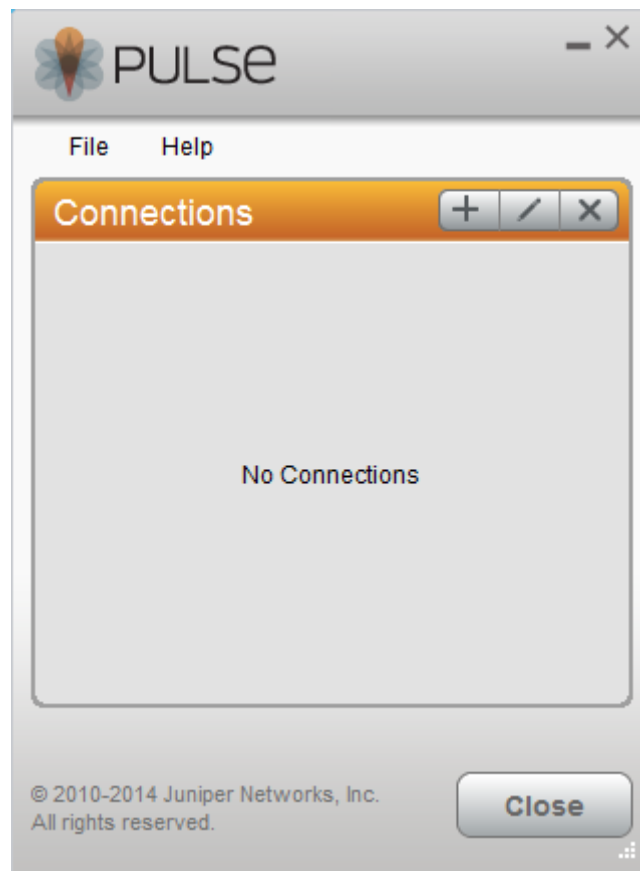
Initial Setup:

Install Junos Pulse for windows client on your computer

(Windows Version)




Open Pulse Secure Client Interface and create new connections... **File > Connections > Add**



Enter a **Name** for the connection: **Vendor IPSEC** (Connection name can be anything you want)

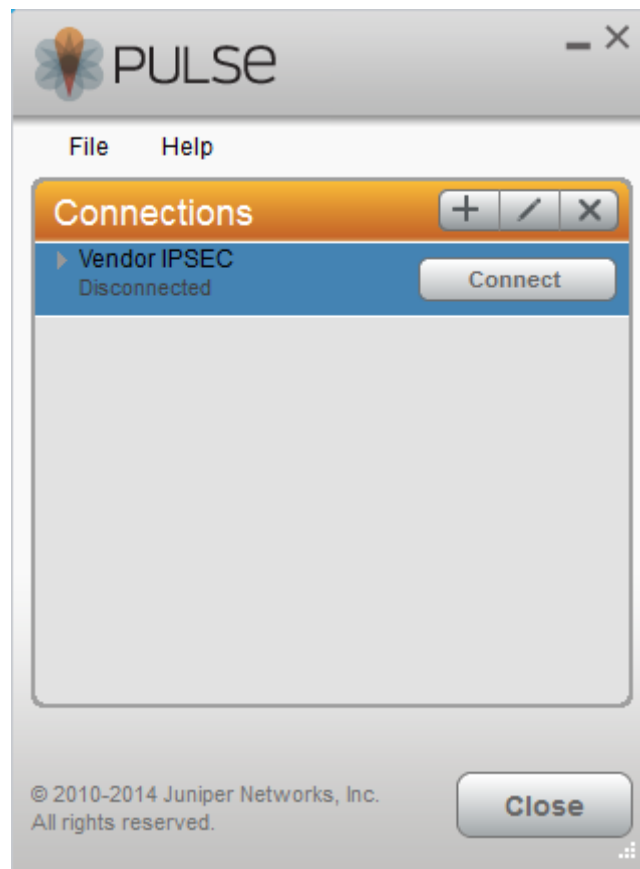
Enter a **URL** for the service: **juno.dor.state.ma.us/vendor/ipsec**

Click the **Add** button to continue.

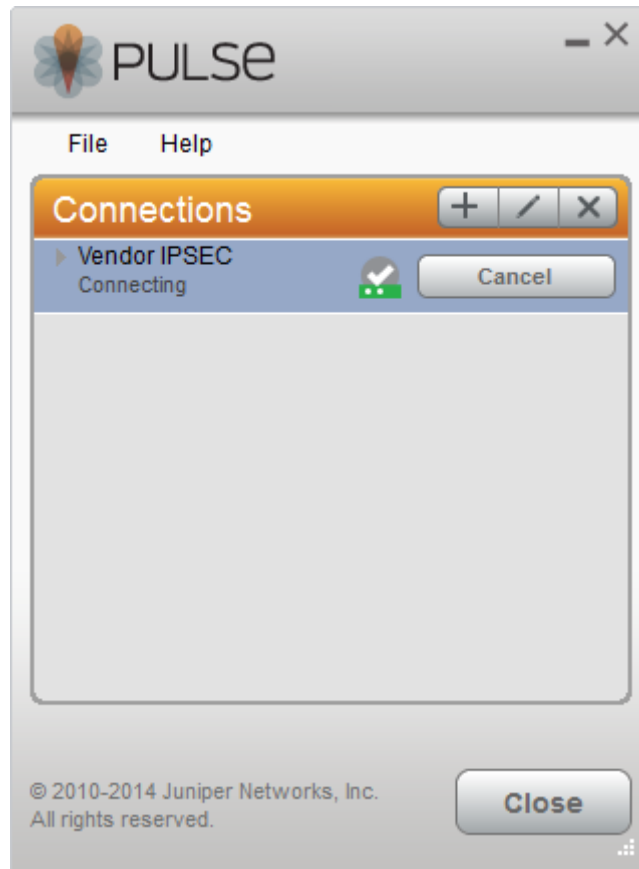

Connecting.... you will then be prompted for User Name and Passcode.



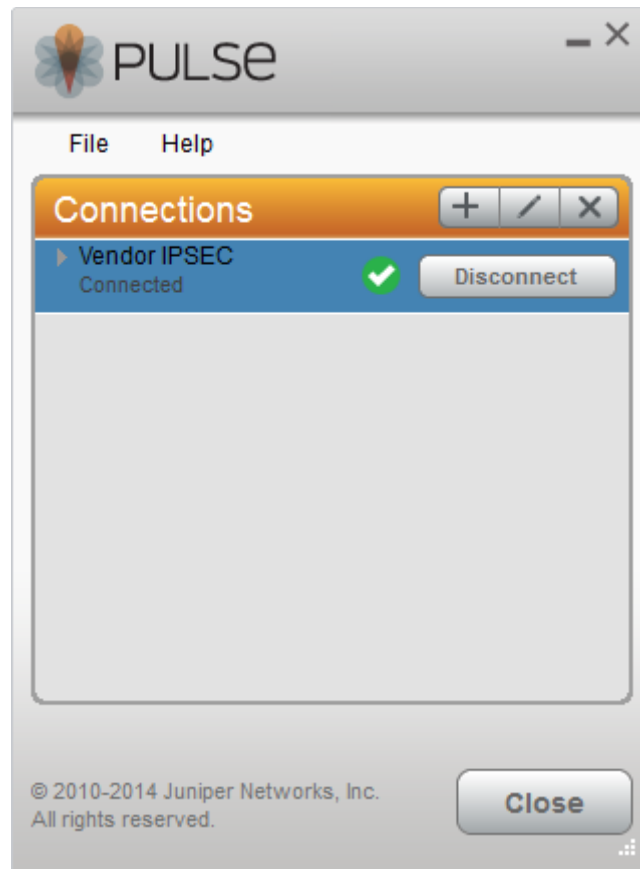
User Name: **Your Active Directory Username**

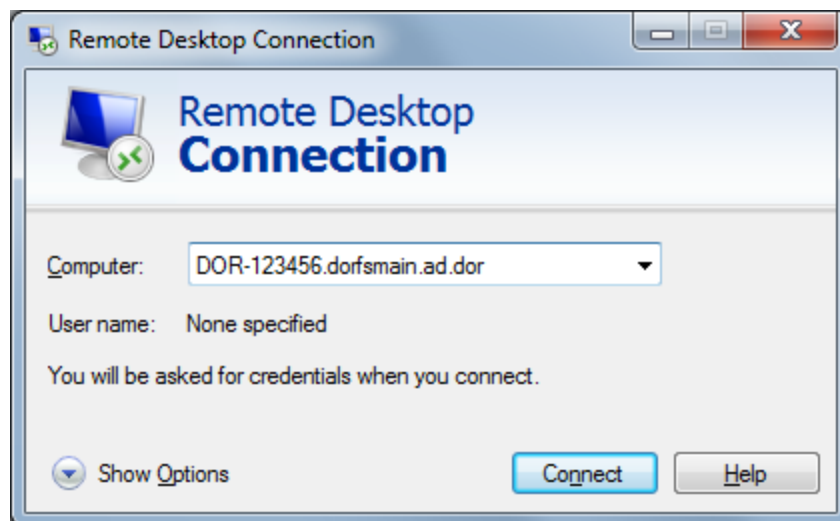


Open Remote Desktop Connection

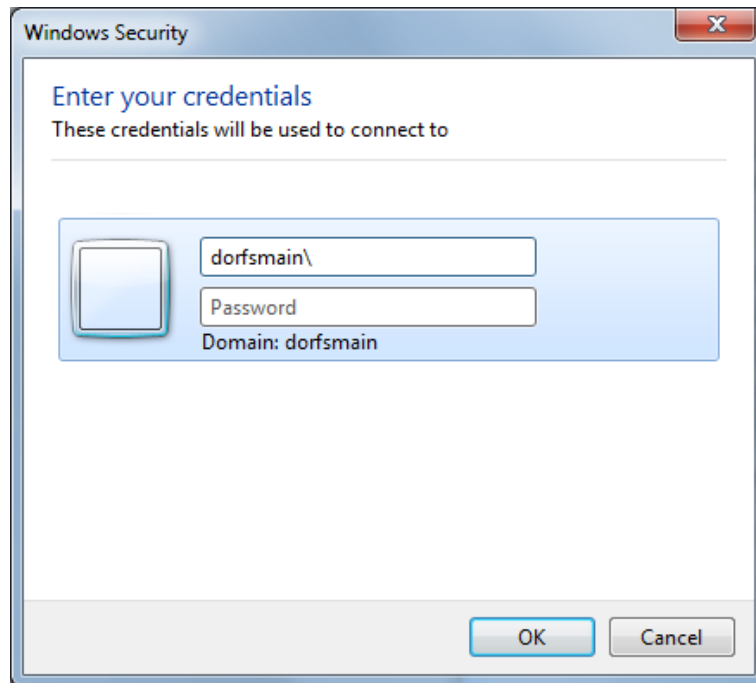
Computer: Enter your work computer's fully qualified domain name you're trying to remotely access in the form, [computer name].[domain]

EXAMPLE: If your computer is named DOR-123456, you would type DOR-123456.dorfsmain.ad.dor

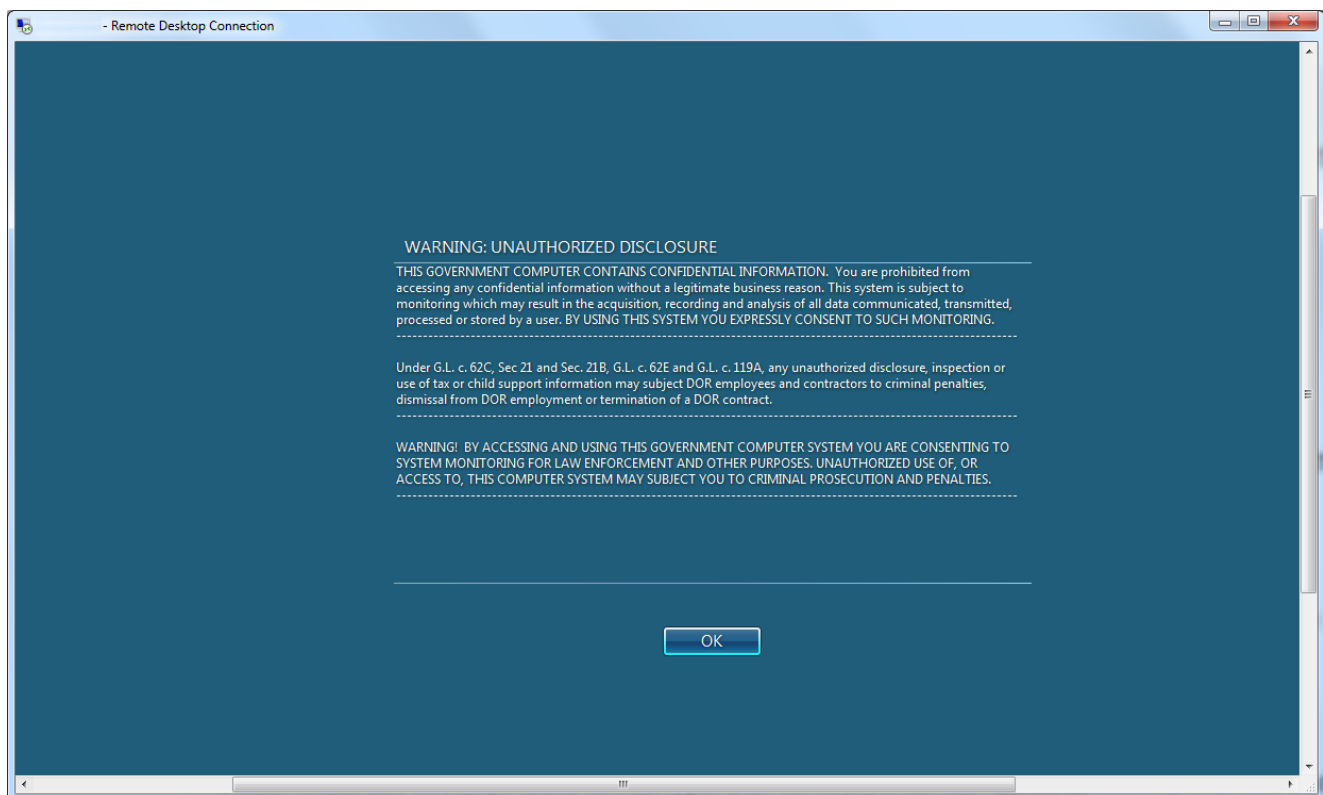
Click on **Connect**



Enter your credentials at sign in, will connect you to the Remote Desktop where you can access the PC in your network. Use **(DOMAIN\Username)** logon format.

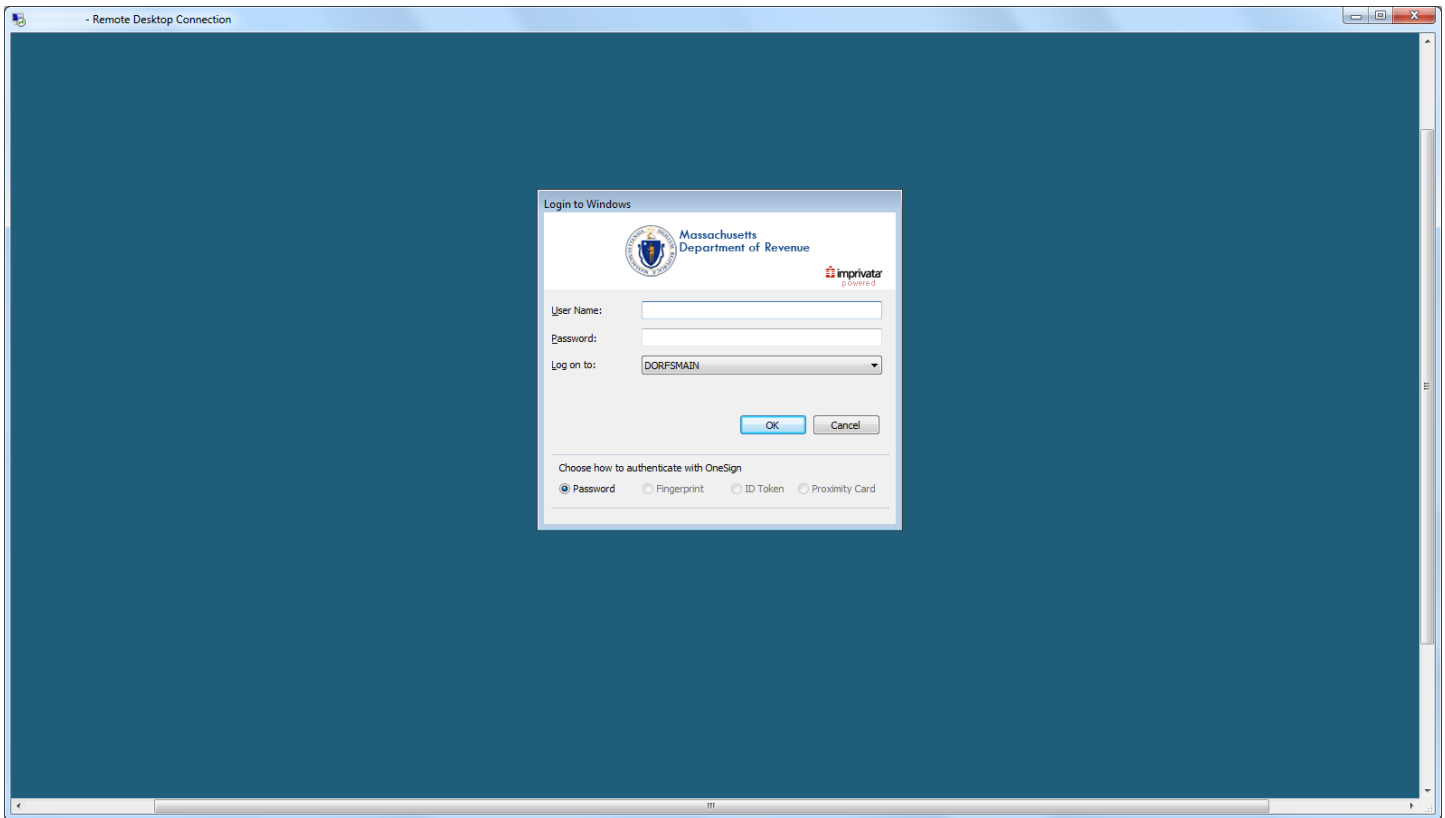


Read the disclaimer and click **OK**



Login with your Active Directory **Username** and **Password**

Click on **OK**



Ending your Remote Desktop Session

- Click the **X** found at the top center of your screen
- Click **OK** – This will disconnect you from your remote connection with your host computer
- Please remember to disconnect from Junos Pulse client as well

IMPORTANT:

When connecting to MDOR VPN, locally you can't access the internet. However, your Wi-Fi stays connected.
