

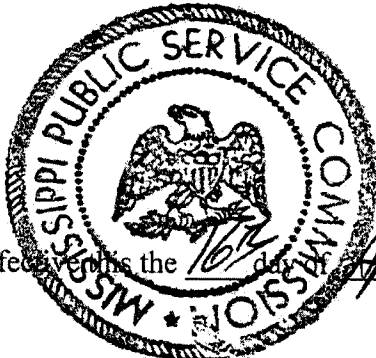

ORDER ALLOWING INTERVENTION


