Re: Update of data on 122 individuals moved out of Medfield and Westborough State Hospitals in 2002-03 initiative

Date: June 10, 2009

On May 26 I presented data on the 122 individuals who moved out of Medfield and Westborough State Hospitals in the 2002-03 initiative to the commission. It was requested that the data be updated to see if there have been significant changes since the recent budget cuts.

To better identify where people are currently residing the categories were broken down further. Since 12/31/07 (the date of the previously reported data), there have been no additional deaths. As of June 9, 2009 there are 12 people in Westborough State Hospital although they are not all the same people who were here in 12/31/07. There are now 2 people in correctional facilities. The number of cases closed to DMH (moved out of state, achieved independence) has increased from 8 to 12.

In January 2009, 31 clients terminated with case management services; they are now being solely overseen by their current service vendor and have a contact at the site office (a supervisor). Sixty two individuals continue with case management.

Eight people had been involved with SEE and transitioned from those services when SEE was cut.
