Basic requirements to apply:

- Be a US citizen (or naturalized before time of appointment)
- Be an official resident of the state and hold a valid driver's license
- Must be 21 years of age at date of hire
- Be a non-smoker
- Have no felony convictions (some misdemeanors are also grounds for disqualification)
- Pass a physical fitness test and medical examination, including a psychological component

Important dates for the application process:

Application Deadline: February 19, 2019 (\$50 late fee for applications received after February 5)

Written Examination: March 23, 2019

Written Examination Fee: \$100
