

MassHealth members who are eligible for Medicare now need to enroll in Medicare.



- MassHealth members who are eligible for Medicare at no additional cost, including Qualified Medicare Beneficiaries (QMBs), are **required** to enroll in Medicare.
- Starting in July 2025, MassHealth began sending members who are eligible for Medicare a notice in a **yellow envelope** telling them to enroll in Medicare.
- If you get a notice in a **yellow envelope** telling you to enroll in Medicare, **you must apply for Medicare at your local Social Security office, before the date listed on the notice, to keep your MassHealth benefits.**
- The yellow envelope will also contain an insert with more information on Medicare and information for the Social Security office. Make sure to bring the **Information for the Social Security Office** insert to your Medicare application appointment so the Social Security office understands your Medicare eligibility and that MassHealth is requiring you to enroll in Medicare.
