
MassHealth members who are eligible for Medicare now need to enroll in Medicare.








 MassHealth members who are eligible for Medicare at no additional cost, including Qualified Medicare Beneficiaries (QMBs), are required to enroll in Medicare.

• Starting in July 2025, MassHealth began sending members who are eligible for Medicare a notice in a **yellow envelope** telling them to enroll in Medicare.

• If you get a notice in a **yellow envelope** telling you to enroll in Medicare, you must apply for Medicare at your local Social Security office, before the date listed on the notice, to keep your MassHealth benefits.

 The yellow envelope will also contain an insert with more information on Medicare and information for the Social Security office. Make sure to bring the Information for the Social Security Office insert to your Medicare application appointment so the Social Security office understands your Medicare eligibility and that MassHealth is requiring you to enroll in Medicare.
