 - 03/25/2019 There were 11,342 EL licenses linked to public user accounts.
 - 04/16/2019 There were 13,211 EL licenses linked to public user accounts.
 - 05/15/2019 There were 15,868 EL license linked to public user accounts.
 - 06/15/2019 There are 26,297 EL Licenses linked to public user accounts.
 - 07/15/2019 There are 34,462 EL Licenses linked to public user accounts.
There are 27,012 licenses renewed.
(There are ~38K licensees up for renewal this cycle)
 - New licenses will be received 4 to 6 weeks after renewed on line.

- Licenses with a 07/31/2022 are presently being issued after successful examination.
- The DPL has installed four computer kiosks in the 7th floor lobby. License holders who need help linking their licenses or renewing can come to the DPL for one to one assistance.
