



New Bedford – Route 18 Corridor Study Public Information Meeting

What is happening?

The Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) Highway Division will be holding a Public Information Meeting to review the study outcomes and design options to improve the Route 18 corridor between Elm Street and Coggeshall Street.

How will this affect you?

The Route 18 planning study is looking to identify and evaluate design concepts to improve access for all users of the corridor, including people walking, people biking, people taking transit, and motorists. The goals of the study are to develop concepts to improve access between Purchase Street and Route 18; improve connections across Route 18 and along Route 18; facilitate economic development along the corridor; and provide access between Route 18 and the new South Coast Rail station. This is the third of four planned information meetings to be held throughout 2021.
