

# MASSACHUSETTS DEVELOPMENT FINANCE AGENCY

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be conducted by the Massachusetts Development Finance Agency ("MassDevelopment") at 10:00 a.m. on Monday, January 30, 2017 at 89 Shrewsbury Street, Worcester, Massachusetts 01604, on the proposal of The Sizer Foundation, Inc. and Francis W. Parker Charter Essential School (together with any affiliates, the "Institution"), 49 Antietam Street, Devens, Massachusetts (the "Campus"), that MassDevelopment approve a project to be owned, used and operated by the Institution located at the Campus (the "Project"), consisting of the following:

(A) Refinancing of the Massachusetts Development Finance Agency Tax-Exempt Commercial Paper Revenue Notes, MassDevelopment CP Program 5 Issue, Tranche 2 (Program Loan), which financed or refinanced (1) the acquisition of an existing building and nine acres of land; (2) the acquisition, demolition and transport of the building from 1401 Main Street, Holden, Massachusetts, to the Campus, and the construction, renovation, furnishing, and equipping of a modular 26,000 square foot two-story building addition (the "Addition") containing 14 new classrooms and the construction of a passage between the building and the Addition located at the Campus; (3) the re-construction, furnishing and equipping of a portion of the building; and (4) miscellaneous capital improvements to the building and the Addition, including construction and repair of the foundation, utilities, paved areas, drainage systems, fire alarms, telephone and internet infrastructure and public announcement systems; and (B) financing miscellaneous capital improvements, including roof repairs to the building and the Addition.

MassDevelopment proposes to refinance the costs of the Project by the issuance by MassDevelopment, acting under and pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws, Chapters 23G and 40D, of revenue bonds in one or more series in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$3,000,000, which bonds will not constitute a debt or pledge of the faith and credit of MassDevelopment or of The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Interested persons wishing to express their views on the Project and the proposed issuance of revenue bonds to refinance the Project will be given the opportunity to do so at the public hearing or may, prior to the time of the public hearing, submit their views in writing to MassDevelopment at 99 High Street, 11<sup>th</sup> Floor, Boston, Massachusetts 02110,


