2025-2030 ESMP Implementation

Today we are seeking ExCom feedback on GMAC long-term planning process

Directives and Guidance on GMAC Activities



Section 92C (b) of the 2022 Clean Energy Act directs the GMAC to:

- Seek to encourage least-cost investments, alternatives to the investments or alternative approaches to financing investments that will facilitate the achievement of GHG reduction goals
- Increase transparency and stakeholder engagement in the grid planning process
- Review and provide recommendations on ESMPs that
 - Maximize net customer benefits and demonstrate cost-effective investments
 - Facilitate electrification of buildings, transportation and other sectors
 - Improve grid reliability and resiliency
 - Minimize or mitigate impacts on ratepayers
 - Provide benefits to low-income ratepayers

DPU Guidance in ESMP Order

- Recommends several areas for GMAC & EDC collaboration between draft plan filings (pp. 81-82)
 - EDC presentations on their forecasting method
 - Discussion of least-cost investments in electric distribution systems
 - Identifying alternatives to investments or financing to minimize or mitigate impacts on ratepayers
- Requires the EDCs to collaborate with the GMAC on sensitivity analyses for 2050 long-term demand assessments to be submitted with the next ESMP filing (p. 139)
- Encourages the GMAC to fully explore each company's investment reprioritization process based on updating the updated forecast in the next ESMP (p. 150)



We propose that the September GMAC meeting be used to **develop a draft long-term strategy for the GMAC** that includes:

- Shared understanding of GMAC's role
- GMAC goals for 2026-2029
- GMAC activities
- GMAC's priority topic areas

Synapse would then produce a draft strategic plan based on the conversation at the September GMAC meeting. This draft plan would then be reviewed, finalized, and voted on by the GMAC.

We expect that having a concrete, actionable outcome of the September meeting will stimulate engagement and discussion among GMAC members.

Process to Develop 2026-2029 GMAC Strategic Plan



Key elements of strategic plan should come from GMAC members

Initial Interviews with GMAC Members

- Start by interviewing several initial members to generate a list of ideas to "seed" GMAC member interviews.
- Interviews could include ExCom members and/or other members who are generally less engaged.

Interviews with Full GMAC Membership

- Then conduct semi-structured group interviews with GMAC members to (a) get new ideas, and (b) get their reactions to the original list of ideas
- We recommend two or more members per interview
- The results of these interviews can be used to determine an agenda and strategy for the September GMAC meeting

September GMAC Meeting

- Consider extending to 3 hours
- The September meeting would be facilitated to (a) generate new ideas, and (b) get all members to express their views
- Facilitation could be by GMAC members, current members of Synapse GMAC consulting team, others at Synapse with facilitation experience, or an outside facilitator

Draft 2026-2029 GMAC Plan

- Synapse to prepare draft plan based on September meeting
- GMAC to review and finalize long-term strategic plan


Update on GMAC Website Design
