RE: REGISTRATION OF FOREIGN PROTECTION ORDERS

A recent bulletin dated October 10, 1996 detailed legislation regarding stalking which amended certain portions of G.L. 209A to grant full faith and credit throughout Massachusetts to protection orders issued in other jurisdictions.

A copy of the legislation (Chapter 298 of the Acts of 1996) was included with that mailing.

This legislation becomes effective Thursday, November 7, 1996.

Enclosed please find information regarding Registry Guidelines and Procedures for the filing of Foreign Protection Orders.

Also enclosed is a form entitled Affidavit of Filing of Certified Copy of Foreign Protection Order. Until we have some indication of the volume of these filings, this form should be xeroxed internally. If a large number of foreign protection orders are filed we will consider making it available through Uniform Printing.

All Registers are asked to share the information in this bulletin with the appropriate Registry personnel.

All First Assistant Registers are asked to share the information in this bulletin with all Assistant Registers and Deputy Assistant Registers.

**REGISTRY GUIDELINES/PROCEDURES
for the FILING of FOREIGN PROTECTION ORDERS**

Pursuant to Chapter 298 of Acts of 1996: An Act Relative to the Crime of Stalking which amends certain sections of G.L.M. 209A.

1. Regardless of residency, plaintiff/petitioner may file copy of foreign protection order in any county in Massachusetts.
2. Affidavit must be accompanied by a certified copy of the foreign protection order.
3. No Affidavit of Care or Custody is required.
4. A copy of the completed Affidavit of Filing of Certified Copy of Foreign Protection Order should be given to the plaintiff/petitioner.
5. If plaintiff/petitioner requests that a copy be sent to the police, the Registry should mail a certified copy of the Affidavit and a xerox copy of the foreign protection order to the police.
6. Docketing: 96D 0001- FP1 or 96W 0001- FP1, etc.
"FP" is the suffix code for Foreign Protection order.
Any Massachusetts case involving the same two parties should be cross referenced on the case folder.
The docket sheet should capture plaintiff/petitioner's name, defendant's name and last known address, and the state where the foreign protection order issued.
7. Registry personnel should send the file to the FSO so that information may be entered into the statewide domestic violence record keeping system. FSO will supply FF number on lower right corner of Affidavit.
8. FSO to return case folder to the Registry for filing.
