DECISION

ABIS Sushi & Hibachi, Inc. dba New Tokyo Steak House ("The Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c.138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("The Commission") held a hearing on August 17, 2010 regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Rose Bailey's Compliance Check Field Report.

Facts

- 1. On, June 1, 2010 at approximately 6:17 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation ABIS Sushi & Hibachi, Inc. dba New Tokyo Steak House.
- 2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a bottle of Budweiser for \$3.95. The underage operative was not asked for identification.

Conclusion

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c.138, §34. As the licensee has had other violations of M.G.L. c.138, the Commission suspends the license for a period of five (5) days.
