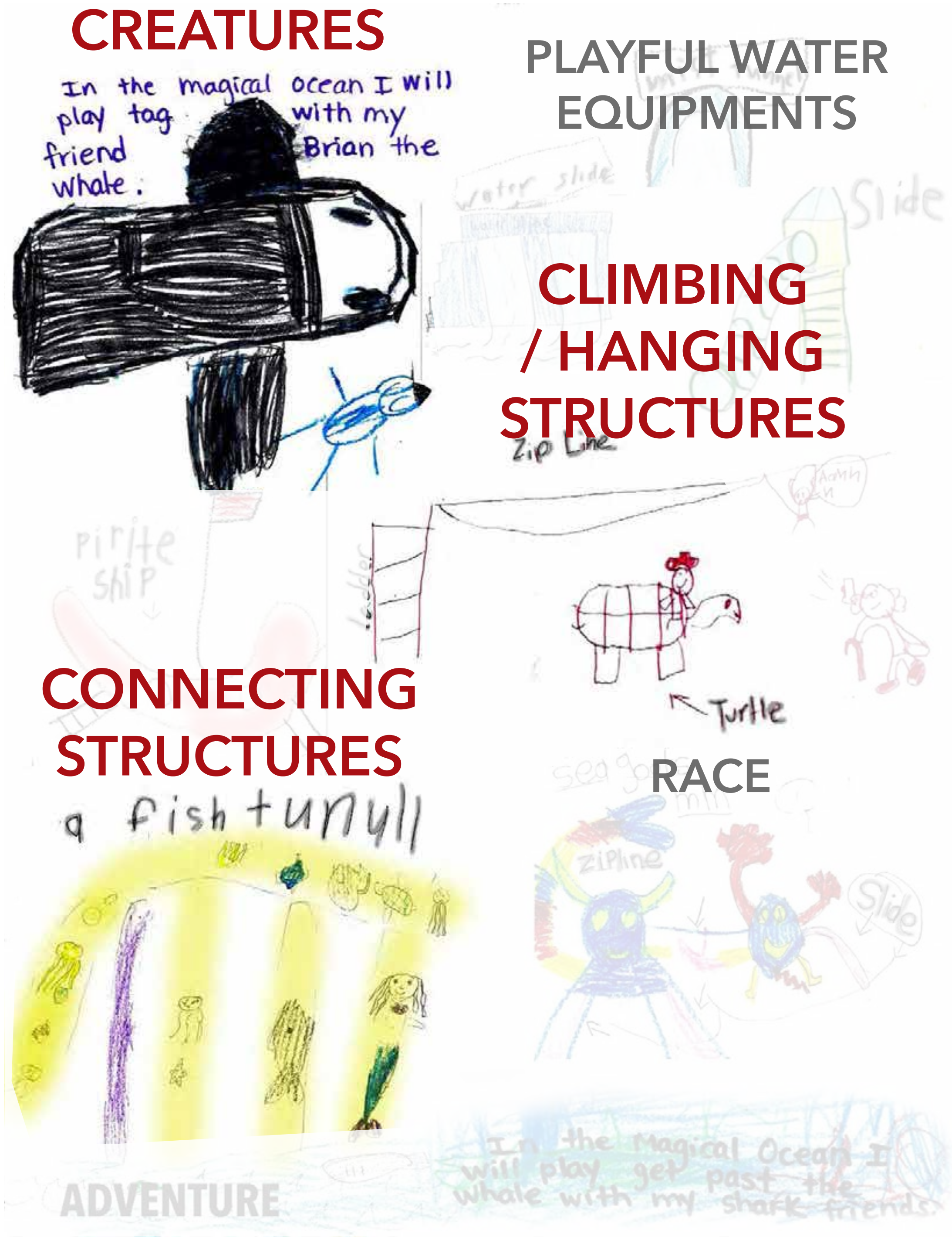

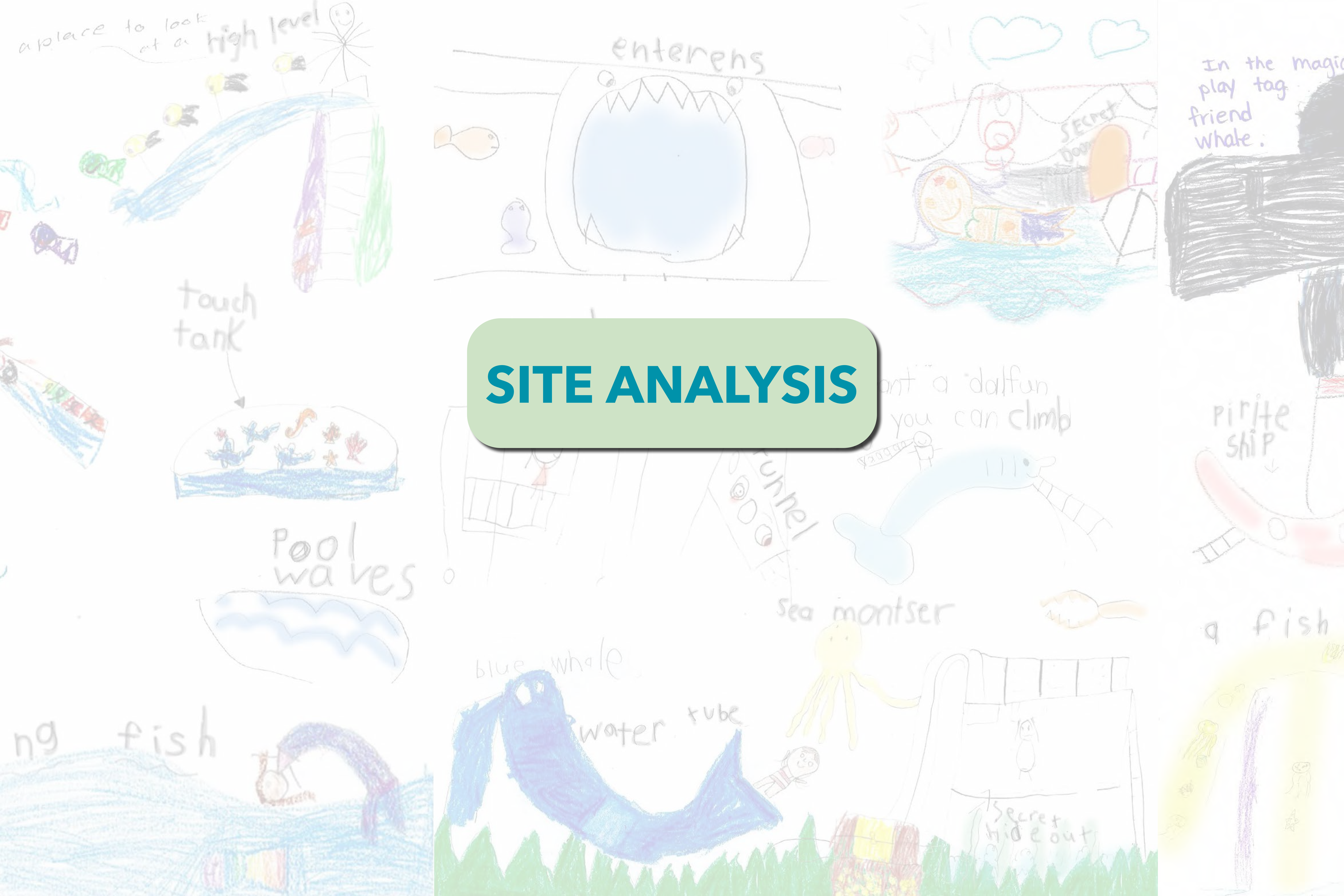
OLMSTED PLAN

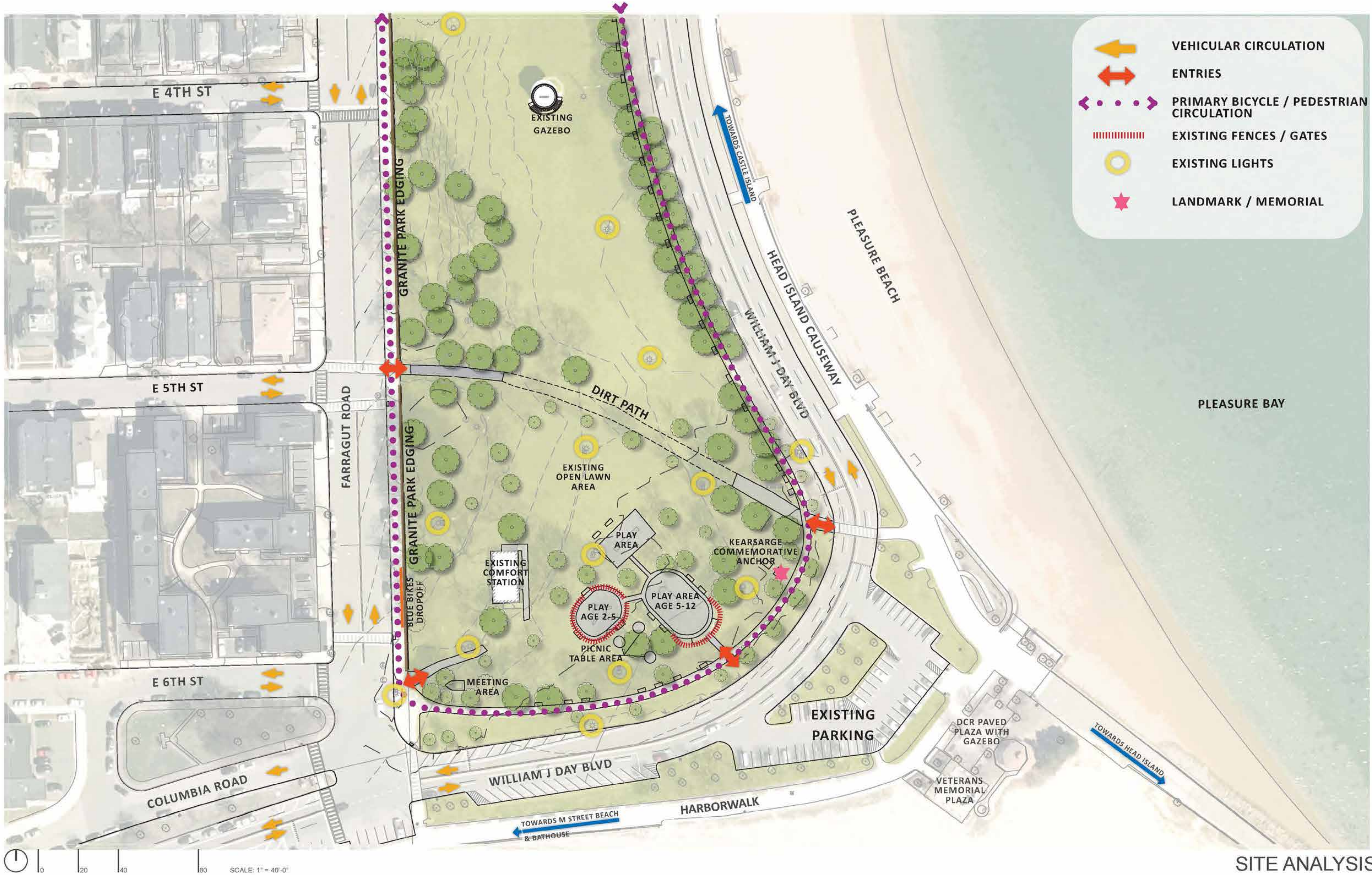




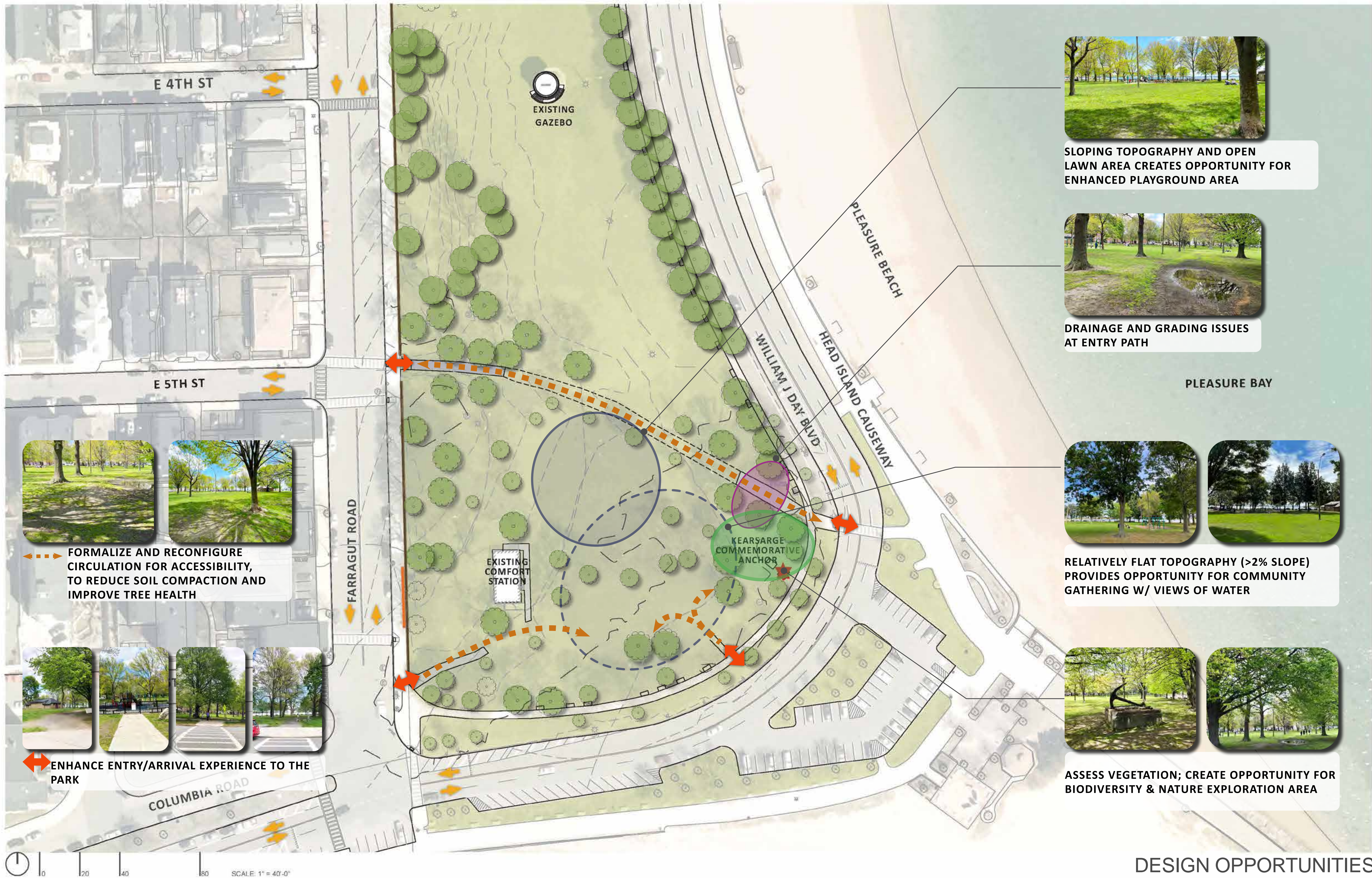


## SITE ANALYSIS

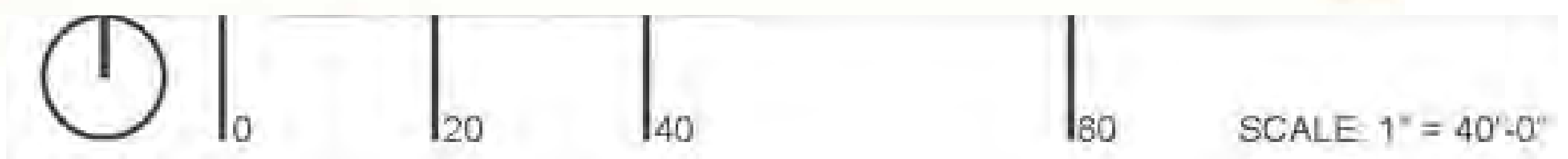

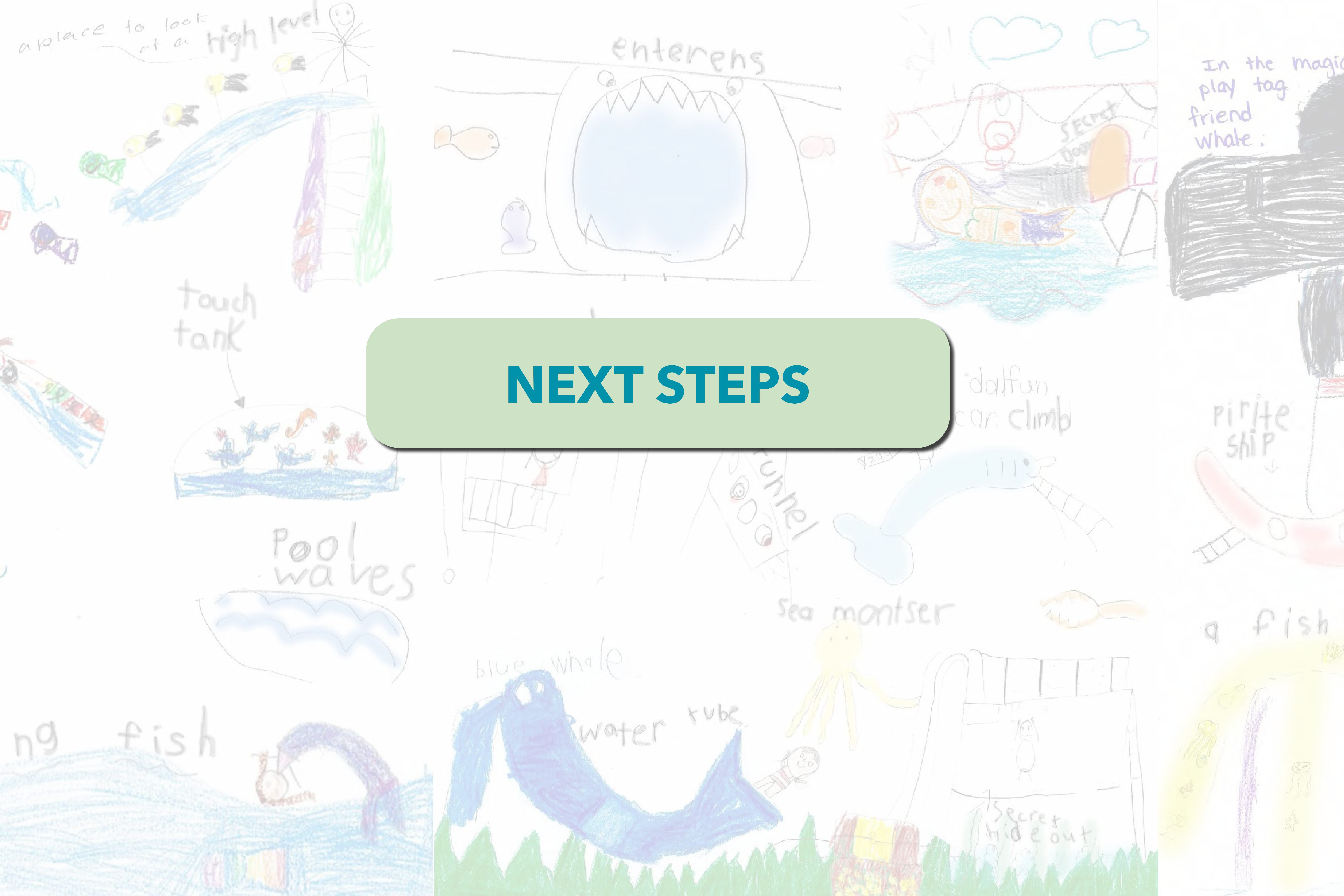

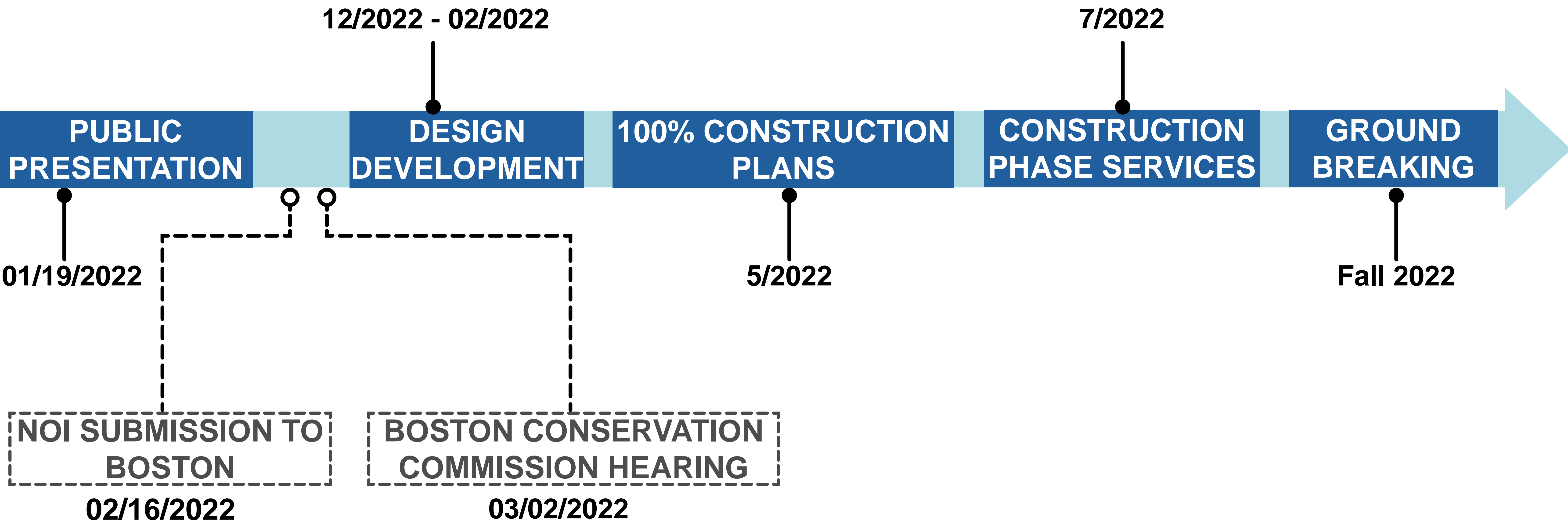
