

Overview



- Removal of concrete microsilica pavement to address delamination
- Microsilica to be replaced with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA)
- Catch basin grates and manhole covers to be replaced
- New pavement markings
- Requesting MassDOT Board approval of \$15.6M contract with the McCourt Construction Company Incorporated
- Construction will take approx. 20 months to complete; staged to in short evening shifts

Purpose and Need



 The wearing surface concrete microsilica is spalling and delaminating and subject to frequent maintenance





Construction Scope



- Lane closures are restricted to occur between the hours of 11:00pm and 5:00am
- Typical Construction Activity

• Milling 12:00am-2:00am

• Cleaning 1:00am-2:30am

Tack Coat 2:00am-3:00am

Pavement 2:30am-3:30am

Construction End Activities

• Inspect & Measure 3:30am-4:00am

Pavement Cooling Duration 3:30am-5:00am

Procurement



- Project was advertised February 22, 2020
- Engineers Estimate was \$23,211,776.00
- Programmed 2020-2024 CIP \$ 21,580,000.
- Bid Opening was May 27, 2020
- Three (2) bids were received:
 - McCourt Construction Co. Inc.
 - SPS New England, Inc.
